_FIRST INSTALL


01 INFLATE THE [AIR FRAME]

Choose the adapted valve for your pump and slightly inflate the [Air frame] so that it stands upright.




02 CONNECT THE [INNER TENT]

Place the [Inner tent] under the inflatable structure and clip each Z-Buckles (x8), as well as T-Bars (x8) to D-Rings (x8) associated.




03 CONNECT THE [FLY SHEET]

Place the [Fly sheet] above the [Air frame] and snap them into the holes at the ends. Then insert the D-Rings (x4). Then clip the Z-Buckles (x8) at the [Air frame] base.



04 INSERT THE [PARALL CARBN]

Deploy the [Parall Carbn] by unlocking the Clips (x4) and snap them into the holes at the ends. Then insert the [Parall Carbn] into the hems of the tent at the ends of the bed, according to the corresponding length.



05 HANG THE [MONOLITH]


Attach the Straps (x2) with a lark's head knot to the upper attachment points.

Place the [Monolith] shelter in the center of the attachment points and pass each strap through the Cambuckles (x4), then the Carabiners (x4) in each of the end caps of the [Parall].



06 STABILISATION OF THE [MONOLITH]

Tie the straps Straps (x2) with a lark's head knot to the lower hanging points.



SET UP


Your camp is ready. Check the installation carefully before entering your [Monolith] and enjoy the experience.

00 PACKING THE [MONOLITH] SHELTER

Unlock the tension by pressing the Cambuckles (x8) until the tent touches the ground.

Detach the Carabiners (x4) from the [Parall Carbn] remove it from the hems of the bed, fold it up by pressing the clips.

NEVER USE THE TENT ONLY WITH THE TOP HANGING POINTS!



GUY LINES


In case of strong winds, pitch the tent on the ground and use the guy lines to secure the camp.

_POLICIES

• MAINTENANCE

Visually and by touch, inspect all components of your MONOLITH for structural damage before each use and dry the tent out entirely before storing it. The MONOLITH should be stored in a safe and dry environment.

• RETURNS

If a manufacturing defect occurs after one year of reasonable use*, the product may be returned for repair or exchange.

• SEVERE WEATHER CONDITIONS

The MONOLITH tent is not intended for use in stormy or dangerous conditions, such as thunderstorms, heavy rain, high winds. Do not use or stay in the MONOLITH tent in these conditions. Do not leave a MONOLITH tent exposed to storm conditions: take it down and store it. Leaving the MONOLITH hanging tent outside and setting it up in bad weather can lead to destruction and/or potential damage (warranty does not cover). If the MONOLITH tent is subjected to such conditions, its suspension system must be fully inspected before further use.

This policy does not cover damage caused by environmental conditions, adverse weather conditions or apocalyptic events.
